Dear guests!

For your own safety, please obey the following fire safety rules in our hotel/guest house

- 1. Smoking is prohibited in the rooms and buildings. Smoking is only permitted in areas specifically marked by "Smoking area" signs.
- 2. It is prohibited to use irons, electric stoves, kettles and other electric heaters in the rooms.
- 3. Do not operate electrical wires and cables with visible damage of isolation.
- 4. It is prohibited to use open flames in buildings and the overall premises.
- 5. Do not leaf power network appliances (TV, radio, air conditioning, lamp, charger) connected, including those in standby mode, when leaving the room.
- 6. Do not cover floor lamps, table lamps and any other items of combustible material with clothes, blankets etc.
- 7. It is prohibited to bring and keep in the room as well as on the hotel premises explosive and fire hazard substances and materials.
- 8. Do not leave small children unattended. Do not allow children to play with matches and lighters.
- 9. Upon arrival, review the hotel evacuation map and try to memorize the location of emergency exits and stairs.
- 10. Please ask our staff with any questions you might have.

In the event of a fire in your room

- 1. Immediately report the incident to a hotel representative
- 2. If eliminating the fire on your own is not possible, exit the room immediately. Close the door but don't lock it.
- 3. Leave the area immediately. Follow the designated exit signs/escape route and act on the instructions of the hotel administration or fire protection.

In case of fire outside your room

- 1. Immediately report the incident to a hotel representative
- 2. Close the windows and doors of your room and exit the building by using the designated exit signs/escape route
- 3. If corridors and stairwells are filled with heavy smoke and leaving the premises is not possible, remain in your room. Open the windows and close the door (a closed and well-sealed door can permanently protect you from dangerous temperature). To avoid smoke poisoning, close cracks and vents with water-dampened towels and bedding.
- 4. Try to contact the hotel about your whereabouts by phone.
- 5. When the firefighters arrive, go to the window and give a sign so they can locate and help you. Strictly follow their instructions.
